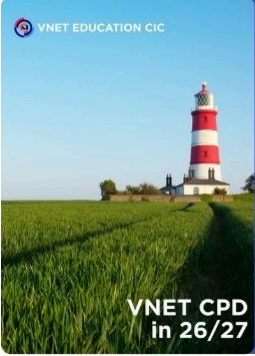
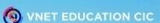
Specialist CPD for SEND 26/27
