This course will teach you how to become a certified coach using the BASIC method. It is a powerful way to structure coaching conversations and to develop the clarity you need to coach with confidence. (The BASIC method was developed by Andy Buck, author of Leadership Matters, and is the preferred method of coaching for some of the latest National Professional Qualification providers.)

The five face-to-face sessions teach the techniques and give opportunities to practice the skills. *Delegates tell us that they have found the sessions practical, insightful and powerful enough to change their practice right from the outset.*
