On 1st February 2024 **Lucy Crehan, author of 'Cleverlands', joins us to share a new perspective on what's possible in education.** Lucy's research took her from Finland and Japan to Canada, Singapore and Shanghai, examining both guiding philosophies and practical strategies for high performance. There will also be a practical workshop where Lucy will present three strategies that your school can implement around curriculum design, student support, and teacher collaboration.

Lucy's keynote will be followed by a panel discussion with Norfolk heads, sharing their experience of how aspiration affects outcomes in their schools.

### **WalkThrus - A Norfolk Cohort**

Many of you will be familiar with Teaching WalkThrus developed by Tom Sherrington and Oliver Caviglioli. The approach provides clear models for learning, based upon a secure evidence base, and we want to create a Norfolk cohort. At the conference, Matt Stone, Operations Director of WalkThrus, will lead a session about the impact of WalkThrus as a pedagogical approach.
